To address these losses and help families reestablish their homes, we accept donations of new and gently-used goods as needed, and according to our storage availability. Below is a list of helpful personal care and household items that are a tremendous help to individuals and families who have transitioned through our emergency shelter or other temporary housing:

## **New or Gently-Used:**

• Kitchenware: pots & pans, utensils & silverware, dishes & glasses, small appliances, measuring cups & spoons, storage containers, etc.

## **New Only:**

- Bath Towels, Washcloths
- Laundry supplies (laundry bags, laundry detergent, spot treatment, bleach, dryer sheets, etc)
- Cleaning tools (brooms & dust pans, mops, buckets, sponges, dish brush or scrubbies, etc.)
- Trash bags
- Paper products (paper towels and toilet paper)
- Feminine Hygiene Products
- Underwear and socks for adults and children

## **CLOTHING**

Please note: We are not accepting donations of gently-used clothing at this time. At CADV we are very fortunate to receive frequent offers of gently-used clothing donations, but we have extremely limited capacity to store clothing. We recommend contacting Raising Hope Free Store located at 956 N. Business Highway 5, Camdenton, MO.
